I. Scorecard update

Dianna shared the Scorecard with the committee. One self-study team, Mathematics, has completed its self-study template. The other teams have not begun to work on their templates yet. Dianna will contact the other teams to remind them of deadlines and set up meetings.

II. Program Review Guide revisions

The committee reviewed and approved minor modifications to the dates on the timeline in the Guide. The committee also voted to add a section to the Guide stating that programs that have been accredited through professional or specialized agencies may request an exemption from the Program Review process, with the stipulation that they (a) provide the committee with a packet of information that covers all of the Program Review requirements, and (b) for the sake of transparency, they attend the Program Review presentations to provide information that highlights their program and be available to answer questions about their program.

The PRC will present these revisions to the Faculty Congress on November 18 for approval.

III. Culinary Program exemption

The committee voted in favor of Culinary's/Dr. Bowman's request for an exemption from the PR process, with the stipulations stated in item II of these minutes. The Culinary program has been accredited by the American Culinary Federation. The Culinary program has been notified of the committee's decision.
