- Open a browser such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safrai to access the internet.
- In the browser address bar, type <a href="http://moodle.navajotech.edu/">http://moodle.navajotech.edu/</a> to access NTU's Learning Management System (LMS) called Moodle.
