The Gene Haas Foundation Scholarship provided through the NTU Center for Advanced Manufacturing is to provide student support through a tuition award and an assortment of tools.

Who is eligible:

This Scholarship is to support students enrolled in the Advanced Manufacturing Engineering Technology, Mechanical Engineering and Engineering Technology degree programs.

What is the Award:

The scholarship provides a for the 2021-22 Academic year will provide a \$500/semester tuition award and tools to include a Mitutoyo electronic caliper (\$188), safety glasses (\$15) and a Texas Instruments Ti84 calculator (\$100). These awards are to provide support for your success at NTU.

How to apply:

Students can download an application from the CAM website at <http://digitaltech.navajotech.edu/scholarships>. The application will be reviewed by the CAM staff and a review board to assess your application.

What will be required:

The award will be provided in two stages: The first stage will be a \$500 tuition award for the fall semester and the tools listed above (\$300 value); the second stage will be a second \$500 tuition award for spring semester. To receive the second stage of the award, the student will be required to complete the online ACE Machining Dynamics course (roughly 6 hours) and the ACE Metrology course (roughly 3 hours) and present the certificates to receive the second stage awards. Registration process for the ACE courses will be provided after awards are made.
