
New & Returning Student Online Orientation


How to Access the Orientation on NTU Website:

Please review the following steps to log-in to start the Online Orientation. You must know your NTU Student Number and Skyhawk email (if you don't have these items please email <u>its@navjaotech.edu</u> for them to create your SSO account).
