NTU and CHIERS Leadership Convene for STEM Competitions

Crownpoint, NM - On February 2nd, 2023, Navajo Technical University and the Consortium for Hispanic and Indigenous Education on Robotics in Space (CHIERS) forged a cooperative agreements to assist faculty and students in research projects. The occasion included STEM related activities that involved the participants closely interacting with emulated NASA missions.

The event featured the Zero Robotics Programming Competition aboard the International Space Station. The contests challenged the students in areas of leadership methods and training, mathematics proficiency, programming, strategic techniques, and robotic information. The event granted the middle school and high school students accessibility to the International Space Station and the opportunity to take their final exam in a near-zero gravity environment.

The event also highlighted teams that started online, challenging them to create, edit, save, simulate, and submit codes for the free-flying robot called the Astrobee. The robot was designed for outer space labor. The Astrobee system is installed with three cube-shaped bots attached with perching arms to help astronauts maneuver on construction missions on the moon or in deep space.



NTU Automotive Toyota Hybrid Synergy Drive Vehicle Training

Crownpoint, NM – On February 10th, 2023, Navajo Technical University received its first hybrid vehicle, a Toyota Prius C. Thanks to fuel-saving technology, the Toyota Hybrid Synergy Drive system automatically switches between electric and conventional engine power. Hybrid Synergy Drive will adapt according to driving conditions as it controls the energy coming from both sources and informs the vehicle how to combine them.

NTU students will receive hands-on experience from Steven Kollas, the Automotive Technology program instructor, who got first-hand training from Andy Tirado, Senior Training Specialist of AVI On Demand. Andy was glad to have had this experience of helping to understand more about this type of vehicle, pointing out possible flaws that may be experienced close to home in rural areas. AVI (Automotive Video Innovations) is dedicated to presenting current technical information to the automotive aftermarket. The content aims to educate today's shop owners, technicians, vocational/technical schools, and colleges.
