NEW CALCULATION OF PELL GRANT ANNUAL AWARD

Pell Grant will be awarded based on Enrollment Intensity.

Example (7 credits divided by 12) X 100% = 58%
(10 credits divided by 12) X 100% = 83%

Pell Grant Award \$ 3,000 X 58% = \$ 1,740
\$ 3,000 X 83% = \$ 2,490

TUITION-FREE COLLEGE FOR NM, AZ, & SOUTHERN UT

The Opportunity Scholarship can be used to cover up to 100% of tuition and required fees at any New Mexico public college or university.

WHAT IS TUITION-FREE COLLEGE?

- + Full tuition and fees covered at New Mexico public colleges and universities.
- + Includes part-time and full-time students.
- + For students pursuing credit-bearing career training certificates, associate degrees, and bachelor's degrees.
- + Includes part-time and full-time students.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- + Students residing in New Mexico, Arizona, and Southern Utah.
- + Be Undergraduate, or not yet earned your 1st degree.
- + Enroll at least six (6) credit hours.
- + Entering freshman must establish eligibility by completing FA25 with a 2.50 GPA.
- + Have less than 90 attempted credit hours towards an associates degree.
- + Or have less than 160 attempted credits toward a bachelor's degree.
