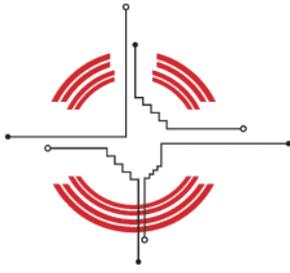

- I. Call to Order - 11:34 a.m.
- II. Attendance - See above.
- III. Approval of Agenda - Dr. Fowler moved to approve, Anusuya seconded.
- IV. Approval of Minutes - Dr. Fowler moved to approve, Dr. Arungwa seconded.
- V. Approval of AY26 Summary Report - Prince presented the highlights from the Summary Report. Due to lack of quorum, the committee could not approve the report. The report will be presented to the President's Cabinet and the feedback will be sent to the committee. Dr. Arungwa asked how management has responded to the recommendations



made by the PRC. Prince explained that the role of the committee is to provide high-level recommendations to the university administration, which is then responsible for taking action on them. He also noted that the report includes updates on actions taken in response to recommendations from previous years. While some improvements have been made, he indicated that there is still room for further progress. Dr. Fowler supported this point and reiterated the same perspective.

Dr. Arungwa further suggested that the committee could consider making dual recommendations to management. For example, if resources are not immediately available to address certain recommendations, the committee could suggest utilizing surplus labor to help implement some of the proposed improvements.

- VI. Choose the top three Reviews for AY26 - The committee assigned scores to each program using a rubric, and selected a first-place program, and a second-place program and a third-place program. The winners will be held confidential until the committee presents their cash award and certificate during Fall 2026 Convocation.
- VII. Program Review Chair/Members for AY27 - The Assessment Coordinator will continue to serve as Chair of the Program Review Committee for Academic Year 2026–2027 until a faculty member expresses interest in assuming the role. The committee welcomes and encourages faculty participation in program review leadership moving forward.
