Transcript Submission:

Official college transcripts from each accredited college attended including conferred day of awarded Bachelor's degree, should be sent to **NTU Admissions/Registrar's Office, PO Box 849, Crownpoint, NM 87313** or send electronic transcripts to **NTU Admissions** at admissions@navajotech.edu:

- ☐ Official College Transcript from each accredited college attended
- ☐ Three (3) current letters of recommendation from professional or academic references, dated within 60 days of the application deadline.
- ☐ Resume
- ☐ A 500-word statement of purpose including your goals, interests, experiences, and any other information that will assist the Graduate Admission Committee in considering your application for graduate admission.
- ☐ All graduate credit hours are expected to be earned at Navajo Technical University.
There might be a possibility that a very low number of graduate course credit hours might be considered for transfer from other institution(s). As determined by Graduate Admission Committee.
- ☐ A copy of an undergraduate research paper is required to assess the applicant's writing skills for admission to the **Master's program.**
- ☐ For the **Ph.D. program**, applicants must submit either GRE scores or three writing samples, each limited to 10 pages. At least one writing sample must include research data. A master's thesis may be included but cannot serve as the sole writing sample.
- ☐ Students must keep contact information current, including phone number, mailing address, and email address.

All required documents will be kept on file. Applicants will receive an official letter of acceptance or denial from the Graduate Committee and the Registrar.

NOTE: Students are **REQUIRED TO BE ON-SITE FOR THE LAB CLASS**, unless credits are earned at another university. Please contact admissions for more information.
